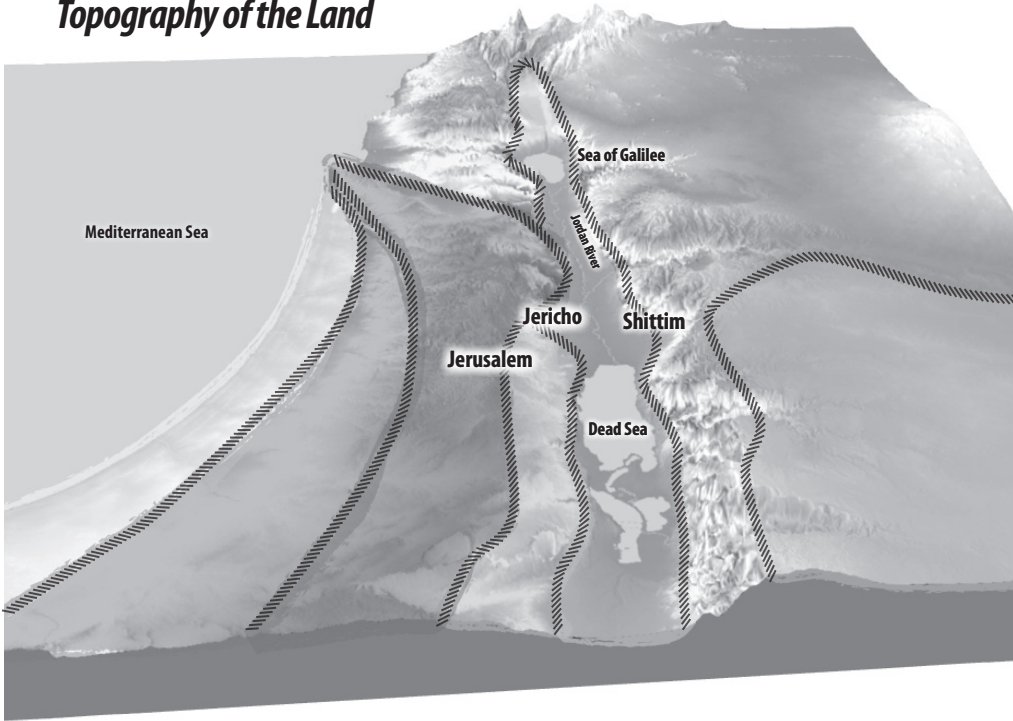


## Joshua 2 | Rahab Hides the Spies

## 1:10 HOMEWORK

1. When in your life have you felt inadequate?
2. **Read 1 Corinthians 6:9-11.** Rahab was an unlikely person (humanly speaking) for God to use. We talked about the strikes against her during the message Sunday. In Jesus, God pardoned them all. What strikes do you have against you? Have you repented of sin to receive God's pardon in Jesus? When?
3. **Read Joshua 2:1-24. Then read Hebrews 11:31 & James 2:25.** When do you think it was that Rahab came to faith?
4. **Read Joshua 2:12-13.** Rahab demonstrated concern for her family, that they might be saved from God's wrath. Who in your family needs to hear from you about Jesus and be saved from God's wrath?
5. Rahab is mentioned as an ancestor of Jesus in Matthew 1:5. She is Boaz's father and King David's great great grandmother. Her repentance and simple faith left a legacy of faith. Who are you leaving a legacy of faith for in your family? How are you doing at actively passing it on? *Pray for yourself.*
6. The two spies engaged who we might consider least likely to respond to Jesus, a prostitute. Who are you least likely to share Jesus with... Why??? *Pray for courage.*
7. In spite of her sin, God loved Rahab. In spite of your sin, God loves you. We deserve hell. But God shows mercy and grace to anyone who trusts Jesus. If you're a Christian, describe a time when God's grace has been evident to you. When is a time you've experienced God's grace in an unmistakable way?

**Read Romans 10:9-13 & John 15:1-17.** Have you responded to the gospel? Do you abide in Jesus? **Make a choice.** Will you trust and abide in Jesus day by day? Or trust in your idols?
