

PEARL is an acronym we use to help you share your story and God's story with those who are far from God.

Below the **PEARL** *strategy* is outlined. But you might also think of that *person* Jesus is sending you to who is far from God as your "PEARL", because of how much they're worth to God, and how much they mean to you!

PRAY for them
PEARL is about helping people find Jesus, and

it beings by praying! Prayer changes circumstances, prayer and prayer changes us! Pray for those God has put in your path. Pray for their problems, pray for the solution, and keep praying they would meet Jesus!

EAT with them

Jesus used meals to connect with people and let them see who he really is. Luke 7:34 says Jesus came "eating and drinking" with people he loved. Share a meal, grab coffee, spend time with that person you have in mind. Meals slow us down and deepen relationships.

ASK questions

Jesus asked 307 questions in the Gospels but only directly answered 8 asked of him. Good questions engage others by showing genuine interest in them, learning their spiritual journey, & encouraging them to think deeper. Jesus was a master at this, follow his example!

REVEAL your story Stories are powerful, so when the opportunity comes be able to share God's Story and ready to share your story of meeting Jesus!

LOVE them tangibly As you share life & the Good News with others, expect various reactions—but remember God will keep working and you must keep loving!

Food for Thought...

ooking back at your notes from this week's teaching, was there anything you eard for the first time, that caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?
Sometimes we're tempted to think that we're the only ones to ever live in culture that's opposed to God or decaying morally. But sin has made this the case in every culture for 1,000s of years dating back to Genesis 3. Yet God calls us to faithfully follow him, which will lead to joy! — What are some of the challenges you face in following Jesus and living with joy in our current society? Which challenge is the biggest for you personally?

- Any cultural answers to our problems are incomplete and temporary. We know from Scripture that Jesus is the truth and anything else will decay. Like Paul preached in **Acts 13:39**, "by Jesus everyone who believes is freed from everything from which you could not be freed by the law of Moses" (or anything else for that matter!). How does that verse, and those that follow help us hold onto truth int he midst of an ever-changing and decaying culture?
