2 Corinthians (Acts 18:1-17)

In life's **HARDEST** circumstances

Each time Paul wraps up his ministry to a church or individual in Acts whom he later writes a letter to, we'll take a week to give an overview of what he wrote to them. This week we're in 2 Corinthians.

#### Where in Acts? Acts 18:1-17

About a year after this first letter, Paul writes again to the church in Corinth. Paul had already written three letters to the Corinthians (two are now lost). In 1 Corinthians (the Why did Paul second of these letters), he used strong words to correct write them? and teach. Most of the church had responded in the right spirit; there were, however, those who were denying Paul's authority and questioning his motives.
