So what is a "Gospel Conversation"?

First of all, by 10,000 we do not mean 10,000 people, but conversations.

A Gospel Conversation is sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ with someone in need of knowing of his love and grace.

A conversation that points to Jesus as the hero and gives testimony to his grace, as well as our own need for it, counts as a Gospel Conversation.

Here's three (of many!) types of Gospel Conversations:

- 1. I share with someone what Jesus is doing in my life today. Maybe something good, maybe bringing me through a hard time, maybe a point from Sunday's message that hit me, etc.
- 2. I share with someone my story of putting my faith in Christ.
- 3. I share the truth of the Gospel, and encourage them to believe it themself.

Remember the key is to love. We're loved by Jesus, and so we're sent by Jesus to love others and invite them to follow him with us.

Live as children of light ⁹ (for the fruit of the light consists in all goodness, righteousness and truth) 10 and find out what pleases the Lord. 11 Have nothing to do with the fruitless deeds of darkness, but rather expose them. 12 It is shameful even to mention what the disobedient do in secret. 13 But everything exposed by the light becomes visible—and everything that is illuminated becomes a light. 14 This is why it is said: "Wake up, sleeper, rise from the dead, and Christ will shine on you." 15 Be very careful, then, how you live—not as unwise but as wise, ¹⁶ making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil.




