### **Digging Deeper**

#### Use this guide for further personal and group study this week.

- 1. The theme verse for the book of Romans is 1:16-17, where we read "For in the gospel the righteousness of God is revealed—a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written: 'The righteous will live by faith.' Can you remember when you first began to hear and/or understand this concept of "living by faith" in regard to following Jesus? Talk about it.
- 2. The book of Romans is our foundational book of the Bible that clarifies our need for Jesus and defines what living by faith looks like. As Pastor Josh said, "it's a book of doctrine applied... it tells us what to believe and how to behave!" Romans 1-7 explains our need for Jesus, while Romans 8 is the pivot point in the book showing us the new life God's Spirit provides for us. As you **read Romans 8:14-39**, <u>underline in your Bible</u> all that has to do with what the Spirit offers us as followers of Jesus, then make a list below..

How do Romans 5:3-5 and the rest of what you just read in Romans 8 help us to better understand 8:28??

<sup>3</sup> Not only that, but we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, <sup>4</sup> and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, <sup>5</sup> and hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us. ROMANS 5:3-5 (ESV)

• Is there a situation in your life where you need help seeing how God is at work even though it may seem he is not?

As you close, take time to pray for each other. Consider **dividing into separate** groups of men and women as you pray for one another.


