I AM Reconciled

EPHESIANS 2:11-22

To “reconcile” means...

- ... to **RESTORE**
- ... to **SETTLE A QUARREL**
- ... to **HARMONIZE / MAKE COMPATIBLE**
- ... to **BRING TOGETHER**

IMPORTANT:

When used concerning the Gospel, reconciliation is not partial, it is **COMPLETE**. To **FULLY** restore, to **FULLY** settle a quarrel, to **FULLY** harmonize, unify, and make compatible.

JEW and **GENTILE** are reconciled in Christ.

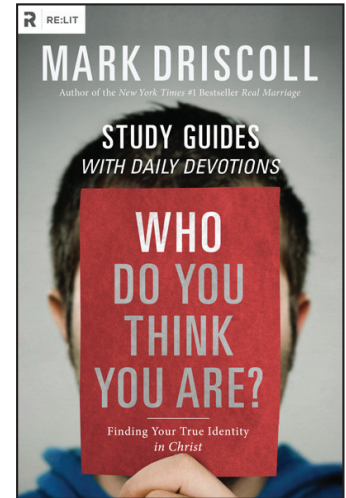
There is no distinction between those who are in Jesus.

YOU and **GOD** are reconciled in Christ.

There is no longer hostility with God for those who are in Jesus.

YOU and **OTHERS** are reconciled in Christ.

There should be no hostility between those who are in Jesus.
