# I AM Adopted

### EPHESIANS 5:1-21

In Jesus Christ, you are adopted. God is your Father. You have a new identity, and a new family. In Ephesians 5:1-21, Paul gives a hefty "Do" and "Don't" list for believers. Your only hope for obedience is knowing your identity in Jesus Christ, adopted as God's child.

### The "Don't" List:

1. Do not **ENGAGE IN SEXUAL IMMORALITY OR IMPURITY.**
2. Do not **ENGAGE IN COVETOUSNESS.**
3. Do not **PARTICIPATE IN FILTHINESS, FOOLISH TALK, OR CRUDE HUMOR.**
4. Do not **ASSOCIATE WITH SINFUL BEHAVIOR.**
5. Don't **TAKE PART IN WORKS OF DARKNESS, EXPOSE THEM.**
6. Do not **GET DRUNK.**

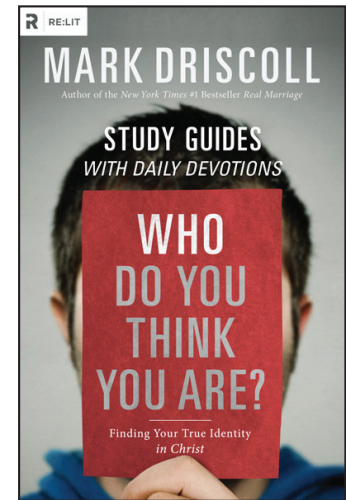
### The "Do" List:

1. Do **IMITATE GOD.**
2. Do **WALK IN LOVE.**
3. Do **WALK AS IN THE LIGHT.**
4. Do **DISCERN WHAT PLEASES GOD.**
5. Do **WALK AS WISE.**
6. Do **MAKE THE BEST USE OF YOUR TIME.**
7. Do **BE FILLED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT.**
8. Do **SING IN PASSIONATE WORSHIP TO GOD.**
9. Do **GIVE THANKS.**
10. Do **SUBMIT TO ONE ANOTHER.**
