1. Don't dwell on the **PAST**. (v.13)

• It can be an excuse for dropping out

• It can be an excuse for sin

- It can be an excuse for complacency
- It can be an excuse for idolatry
- What's holding **you** back???

2. Keep Your Eyes on **JESUS** (v.13-14)

- •1 Corinthians 13:12
- Colossians 3:1-4
- Hebrews 12:1-3
- 1 Corinthians 9:24
- 2 Timothy 4:7-8

3. Dwell On/Remember GOD'S GRACE (v.15-16)

- Think this way... it's a CHOICE!
- Hold on to what you have attained!
 - Let it define you... revel it in... it supersedes any and every other thing!

- 11. What is the ultimate goal or prize a Christian is chasing? **See Philippians 3:20; 1** Corinthians 13:12; 1 John 3:2-3; Revelation 22:3-4
- 12. How does v. 15-16 show the need for humility, patience, and unity in the church?
