Questions & Scripture for Further Study

1. This weekend, we looked at Jesus's prophecy about some of the end times and his return. The Bible also speaks about judgment at that time for all individuals. The topic of judgment can be uncomfortable or confusing to many people, and it's hardly politically correct these days. That's why it's important for us to take a look at what Jesus and the Bible actually say about it. How does the Bible describe the reality and consequences of judgment in each of the following verses?

Matthew 13:42

Grow.

Matthew 25:41, 46

2 Thessalonians 1:9-10

Revelation 14:9-12

Because of the severity of the biblical descriptions of judgment and hell, some people question how it fits in with God's love. How do you reconcile God's love with the truth that he will also judge people? 2. Fear is one of those responses/emotions that can be confusing to understand, especially when you begin talking about God's judgment. How do the following verses help you understand what it means to have a healthy fear of God as opposed to a fear that paralyzes us or causes us to live in worry or dread?

Proverbs 16:6

Proverbs 1:32-33

Jeremiah 32:39-40

3. All of us want to be ready for Christ's return, and to know what to do before he returns. How does **1 Peter 4:7-11** help us live out this week's teaching?
