What is the Gospel? Good News!

The word gospel literally means "good news" and it shows up 93 times in the New Testament. The Gospel is, broadly speaking, the whole Bible; more narrowly, the Gospel is the good news concerning Christ and the way of salvation. **It's at the foundation of our Christian faith.**

One helpful way to think about the Gospel is to think of it in terms of directions on a map.

Let's say you wanted to drive to Fairbanks, Alaska. Chances are you wouldn't just hop in the car and start driving, hoping to end up in Fairbanks. You'd look up directions. Along the route would be a number of waypoints you'd have to pass by in order to make it safely there.

In our metaphor of the Gospel the endpoint isn't Fairbanks, it's Jesus. The destination isn't Alaska, it's being made right with God, and enjoying him forever in heaven.

So how do you get there? Follow the waypoints of the Gospel.

1. God created you to know him, love him, and be loved by him. GENESIS 1:26-27 | JOHN 3:16

2. All of us sin, separating us from God and resulting in death. ROMANS 3:23 | ROMANS 6:23 (This is the bad news...)

3. But the good news is Jesus died in our place and rose from the grave, so that we might know God's love and have real life. ROMANS 5:8 | EPHESIANS 2:4-5

4. The only way to know and experience this is to believe on Jesus Christ. ROMANS 10:9 | JOHN 1:12

To be made right with God (i.e. become a true Christian), simply proclaim "Jesus is my Lord," and believe in your heart God accepted Christ in your place and raised him from the dead.

You might pray something like this: "Lord Jesus, I need you. Thank you for dying on the cross for my sins. I believe you are Lord, and I receive you as my Savior. Thank you for forgiving my sins and giving me eternal life. Take control of my life. Change me. Make me the kind of person you want me to be. Amen."

In reality, point 4 alone contains the directions. Jesus said, "I am the way... no one comes to God except through me." But the other 3 points are waypoints to ensure you find yourself on the right road... believing on/ putting your faith in/trusting Jesus.

Consider using these points to help you share the Gospel with someone. Read and memorize the Scriptures listed as well. They'll help you share your faith AND strengthen your life in Jesus.
