

#### Digging Deeper – A Bible Study

It's no secret the holidays can bring a unique mix of emotions and experiences - friends, generosity, parties, isolation, stress and failed expectations. The good news is that as followers of Jesus we can remain hopeful even when nothing seems to be in the "Christmas Spirit." (Stop and go read **Philippians 4:6-7**) The foundation to our hope is practicing praise for who our God is and what he's done for us. The questions below will help you celebrate Christmas and not just get stuck in the holidays.

### Study Guide (continued)

- What can we learn about God from this passage?
- What do we learn about Mary?
- What good things had he done for her?
- 2. Take two minutes and write down everything you're thankful for. If you have a hard time coming up with anything, maybe start with just today, as well as everyone and everything you have that you can be thankful for (there's a lot!).
- 3. Take two minutes and write down everything you're thankful **God has done** for you.
  - Now go **read Psalm 104** and see what else you can add to your list of praise.
  - Looking back at what you wrote, put a star next to your top seven things that are the most important for you to remember and give thanks for. Create a way to thank God for one item each day of this next week (post it on the mirror, in your calendar, text with a friend, etc.).
- Pastor Josh mentioned that it's likely Mary had the song of Hannah in mind as she was praising God. Do you have songs of praise that resonate with you? That you sing (aloud or internally) often? Why?
- 5. Go read Hannah's song in 1 Samuel 2:1-10. (It will help if you first remember the backstory. To do so, read all of 1 Samuel, chapter 1. Read it slowly. Enter in to all of Hannah's emotion...)
  - As you read, mark all the parallels you see between Hannah's song and Mary's song.
  - Hannah praised God after her great struggle, Mary praised God in the shadow of great struggles coming. What are your struggles these days? **Read and pray** Mary's and/or Hannah's song, and list your own "affliction" and "humble estate" — Turing your attention and faith to the goodness of God to vou.

#### **Prayer**

As you close, take time to pray for each other. **Divide into separate groups of men** and women and pray for one another.
