# Digging Deeper – A Bible Study

1. This week we saw that Mary's obedience to God resulted in some struggles. At times she may have even wondered where God was in the midst of it all. Choosing to not "squirm out" and short circuit the growth process our struggles fuel can be no small challenge, especially when it seems like God is waiting at the other end, but not doing anything now to help the situation.
