Getting To Know You...

Welcome to Life Group! One of the big goals for your Life Group is to continually get to know each other more and more. **This week let's learn play "2 Truths and a Lie".** Give everyone a few minutes to write down two truths about themselves and one lie. Then go around the room and have everyone take turns reading their list of 3 to the group and see who can guess which one is the lie! After you guess the lie, be sure to ask some more questions about the truths and get to know each other more!

Looking back at your notes from this week's teaching, was there anything you heard for the first time, that caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?

Digging Deeper

Use this guide for further personal and group study this week. For the most impact in your life and in your group, *work through it on your own before you gather with your Life Group.* If your Life Group isn't gathering this week, use this guide for further study personally.

- One affect of believing Jesus's Gospel is that it tightens your heart in relationship to people and loosens your heart in relationship to things. (Go back and read Acts 4:32-35 to see what I mean.) — How might believing the following verses loosen your heart in relationship to things?
 - ¹The earth is the Lord's and the fullness thereof, the world and those who dwell therein, ² for he has founded it upon the seas and established it upon the rivers. **PSALM 24:1-2** (ESV)
 - ¹⁷ Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change. **JAMES 1:17** (ESV)
 - ¹³ Someone in the crowd said to him, "Teacher, tell my brother to divide the inheritance with me."

 ¹⁴ But he said to him, "Man, who made me a judge or arbitrator over you?" ¹⁵ And he said to them,
 "Take care, and be on your guard against all covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the
 abundance of his possessions." ¹⁶ And he told them a parable, saying, "The land of a rich man
 produced plentifully, ¹⁷ and he thought to himself, 'What shall I do, for I have nowhere to store my
 crops?' ¹⁸ And he said, 'I will do this: I will tear down my barns and build larger ones, and there I will
 store all my grain and my goods. ¹⁹ And I will say to my soul, "Soul, you have ample goods laid up for
 many years; relax, eat, drink, be merry." ²⁰ But God said to him, 'Fool! This night your soul is required
 of you, and the things you have prepared, whose will they be?' ²¹ So is the one who lays up treasure
 for himself and is not rich toward God." **LUKE 12:13–21**(NIrV)
 - For extra credit, go read Luke 12:22-34 and answer that same question!
 - Is it wrong to desire things? To have nice things? Many things? Expensive things?


