

Digging Deeper

Use this guide for further personal and group study this week. For the most impact in your life and in your group, work through it on your own before you gather with your Life Group. If your Life Group isn't gathering this week, use this guide for further study personally.

- 1. This week we saw Stephen empowered by the Holy Spirit to witness and share the Gospel of Jesus with a hostile audience. Do you have anyone in your life that might be considered "hostile" to the Gospel? On a scale of 1 to 10, how would you rate their hostility? (1 = just indifferent to it all, 10 = would totally slam the door in your face)
- Doing the work of God involves winning over his enemies, not arguing with them. This is a big challenge given the polarizing culture we live in. As followers of Jesus we are free to express our opinions, but we need to be careful to do so in a way that is respectful and loving. How could the following verses help shape how we communicate with those we disagree with?

Unfortunately, life's distractions often cause us to focus our time on less important tasks and keep us from drawing near to God. What priorities do the following verses encourage us to engage in and not put off until a more "convenient" time?
