 - Do you see Paul's attitude reflected in Philip's actions anywhere in Acts 8?
 - What does Paul's prayer request suggest is important about his dependence on God?
 - How might Paul's instructions influence the way you walk through doors God opens for you?
- 3. Is there someone in your life you are building an intentional relationship with right now? If so, what is the next step? If not, who is someone in your circle of influence that you could build an intentional relationship with?
