- As Saul returned to Jerusalem, Barnabas was a friend and encourager to him (Acts 9:26-27ff). It was remarkable because Saul had been an enemy to Barnabas and the other believers before his conversion, but Barnabas showed great humility and forgiveness toward Saul. Other places in Acts Barnabas shows great generosity (4:36-37), encouragement (11:19-30; 15:1-35), and mercy (15:36-40). Study Romans 15:1-6 below and note where you see these same traits commended and on display.
  - **Circle** or **highlight** any words or phrases that catch your attention.
  - **Underline** what you think is important to remember.
  - **Put an X** next to anything that confuses you.
