And by him we cry, "Abba, Father." ¹⁶ The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children. ¹⁷ Now if we are children, then we are heirs—heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory. **ROMANS 8:12-17** (NIV)

- What challenges do you face trying to tap into God's power to live the Christian life?
- Where could you go to find help in order to more consistently tap into God's power?
- Relying on God's power does not mean we give up personal responsibility in making good choices to live the Christian life. God is calling us to live a life of "active dependency." How could you balance relying on God's power while still maintaining personal responsibility to actively obey?
