# Study Guide (continued)

- We're only told that Peter and John (**John 18:15**) stayed close to see everything that was happening to Jesus. Everyone else fled after he was arrested in the Garden. (Matthew 26:56) Does Peter get any credit for his courage to follow him into the city? Do you blame the others for fleeing?
- Why do you think Peter denied Jesus three times? Do you think it was just fear at play? Have you ever feared to follow Jesus or answer to your others about your faith?
- Would Jesus's words in **Matthew 10:28** have helped Peter in that moment? Do you think he remembered them later?
- 3. Have you ever experienced a strained relationship with someone after a time of denial or betrayal? Were you able to reconcile or repair the relationship? How?
  - In John 21:15-19 Jesus and Peter's relationship was restored. Do you think it was hard for Peter to face Jesus again after his resurrection?
- 4. Study Hebrews 12:1-3 below.

<sup>1</sup>Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a huge crowd of witnesses to the life of faith, let us strip off every weight that slows us down, especially the sin that so easily trips us up. And let us run with endurance the race God has set before us. <sup>2</sup> We do this by keeping our eyes on Jesus, the champion who initiates and perfects our faith. Because of the joy awaiting him, he endured the cross, disregarding its shame. Now he is seated in the place of honor beside God's throne. <sup>3</sup> Think of all the hostility he endured from sinful people; then you won't become weary and give up. HEBREWS 12:1-3 (NLT)

- What's the "Therefore" referring to in verse 1? (Hint: **Read Hebrews 11**)
- How do these verses (and Hebrews 11) encourage you to keep going, keep repenting, and keep following Jesus even after times you've failed?
