Questions & Scripture for Further Discussion

Getting to Know You

Starters *(everyone choose one)*

- For you, what is the greatest day of each year?
- Describe a time you were very thirsty (literally or metaphorically).

Message Reflection

- What stood out to you from the teaching this past weekend?
- What questions did the message prompt in you?

Scripture Discussion

As you begin, have someone read **John 7:37-39**.

- What do you think Jesus means by *"believes in me"*? (**verse 38**)
- What do you think Jesus means in the entirety of **verse 38**?
- Why do you think Jesus uses so many metaphors?
- Why do you think John explains the metaphors?

- How would your environments (school, team, club, work, etc.) change if people understood this message and lived it out?
- Who do you know that might be interested in attending an upcoming service at Wawasee Bible?

Do some prep ahead of time! Study the passage on your own, jot down some of your own questions.
