Study Guide Questions & Scripture for Further Study

The questions here are based on the sermon each week (often a related part of Scripture), and guide each group's study. Digging Deeper – A Bible Study

Use this guide for further personal and group study this week. For the most impact in your life and in your group, *work through it on your own before you gather with your Life Group.* If your Life Group isn't gathering this week, use this guide for further study personally.

- Read Genesis 11:27 thru 12:9. Looking back at your notes from this week's teaching, was there anything you heard for the first time, that caught your attention, challenged, or confused you? Discuss it with your group before moving on.
- 2. Have you ever felt torn, like Abram, between what you felt God was calling you to do and what your friends, family, or neighbors expected you to do? How did you respond? What types of pressures did you face?
 - Have you ever found yourself in the opposite position—trying to talk friends or loved ones out of what they thought God wanted for them?
- Below are two interpretations the ancient Jewish tradition (and people) held concerning Abram. Discuss them with your group. What strikes you about them?
 - The idea that God called Abram simply because he wanted to, apart from Abram's merit, was unfathomable to ancient Jewish readers of the Bible.
 - Ancient Jewish readers focused on Abram's righteousness, not God's faithfulness to Abram.
 - What are the dangers of these views?
 Do you see any similarities with "religion" today?

All the families on earth will be **blessed** through you." 4 So **Abram** departed as the LORD had instructed, and Lot went with him. Abram was seventy-five years old when he left Haran.

Study Guide (continued)

- Have you ever struggled to accept God's grace? Did you find it hard to believe that he loves and accepts you as you are? How have you learned to trust God's love for you?
- Pastor Josh mentioned that just as God chose and sent Abram he has also chosen and sent **us**... not just to follow him, but also to be used by him as we love, influence, and encourage others. Study Colossians 3:12-17 below and mark it up. Then write down some specific examples of how "putting on" the various character qualities it lists can have an influence at your work, home, or with your friends.
 - **Circle or** highlight any words or phrases that catch your attention.
 - **Underline** what you think is important to remember.
 - **Put an X** next to anything that confuses you.

12 Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience, ¹³ bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive. 14 And above all these put on love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony. 15 And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body. And be thankful. ¹⁶ Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God. ¹⁷ And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him. **COLOSSIANS 3:12-17** (ESV)
