### **RELIGION** brings a second death (3:1-2)

religion doesn't work Romans 3:20; Galatians 2:16; Ephesians 2:8-9

two deaths Revelation 20:14; Romans 6:23; Hebrews 9:27

but **THE SPIRIT** offers a second birth, (3:3-8)

two births 1 Peter 1:3, 23; Ephesians 2:4-5; Ezekiel 36:26-27; 1 John 5:1

you can choose it, but you can't control it v. 8 John 1:12-13; 1 Corinthians 2:11-12; Numbers 21:4-9

and what you do with **JESUS** determines your fate. (3:9-18)

rejection leads to death Romans 1:18-22; 2:5-6; Isaiah 53:6; Matthew 25:46

receiving leads to new birth & life v. 14-18 Revelation 2:11; Deuteronomy 30:19; John 11:20-27

Questions & Scripture for Further Study

The questions here are based on the sermon each week (often a related part of Scripture), and guide each group's study. #### **Getting to Know You**

Part of our goal at Life Group is just learning more about each other. Toward that end, take some time to catch up with each other as you gather.

If it helps, here's a question to discuss and get you going. Have everyone answer:

If you could pick one everyday task—like making coffee, driving to work, or walking the dog—where you'd love to hear God's voice giving you a little nudge or direction, which would it be and why?

#### **Digging Deeper - A Bible Study**

**Use this guide for further personal and group study this week.** For the most impact in your life and in your group, *work through it on your own before you gather with your Life Group.* If your Life Group isn't gathering this week, use this guide for further study personally.

- Read John 3:1-21. Then review your message notes. Looking back, was there anything that particularly caught your attention, challenged or confused you this week? Discuss it with your group before moving on.
- 2. Why do you think Nicodemus came to Jesus at night? Pastor Josh suggested some possibilities. Do you agree?
  - One he suggested was "restlessness". How might religion leave us restless or insecure today?
  - Is there anything you'd look at in life that isn't "a religion" per se, but can be religious in its devotion or demands on people? Does it create a similar restlessless? If so, in what ways?
- 3. Look up Romans 3:20-23 and Galatians 2:16. How do these passages show that religion alone can't save us, and what do they point us toward instead?
  - What shifts (and/or what changes) when we move from rule-following to trusting Jesus?
- 4. Jesus makes a big statement to Nicodemus in **John 3:3**. Why do you think it was so confusing to him?
  - How would you describe what it means to be born again to someone?

Find the words **bolded** below.

- <sup>5</sup> Jesus answered, "What I'm about to **tell** you is **true**. No one can enter God's kingdom without **being born** through water and the Holy Spirit. 6 People give birth to people. But the **Spirit gives birth** to **spirit**. <sup>7</sup> You should not **be** surprised when I say, 'You must all **be born again**.' 8"The wind **blows** where it wants to. You hear the sound it makes. But you can't tell where it comes from or where it is **going**. It is the same with everyone who is **born** through the **Spirit**."

## Study Guide (continued)

- 5. **Read Jesus's response in 3:5-10.** What's required to enter the Kingdom?
  - Why does Jesus mention the Holy Spirit as part of this exchange? What clues do these verses give: Titus 3:4-7; Romans 8:8-11; John 6:63
  - Martin Luther, in his commentary on the Aposle's Creed, writes, "I believe that I cannot by my OWN reason or strength believe in Jesus Christ my Lord or come to him. But the HOLY SPIRIT has called me by the gospel, enlightened me with his gifts, sanctified and kept me in the one true faith..." How does this help us understand what it means to be "born of the Spirit"?
- 6. Jesus tells Nicodemus he shouldn't have been surprised (v. 7) and that in fact he should have known these things (v. 10). First, why do you think he should have known?
  - Now look up the following passages from the Old Testament. Nic was a teacher of God's word, and the Old Testament is what he would have regularly taught. After this exchange with Jesus, what light do you think it shed on things the next time Nicodemus went and read these passages?

Ezekiel 36:26-27

Jeremiah 24:7; 31:33-34

Isaiah 43:18-19; 44:3-5

#### **Taking it Home & Prayer**

7. This interaction between Nicodemus and Jesus gives us a glimpse into God drawing Nicodemus to himself. Before you wrap up, how did God work to draw you to himself? What's your story of being "born again"? — Maybe you're unsure. Have you sensed God drawing you? Talk about these things in your group. Share your stories with each other.

As you close, take time to pray for each other.
