 **RESPOND** with faith intact when opportunity arises, (41:14-45)

and **MAINTAIN** trust in God alone when/if success comes. (41:46-57)

Food for Thought...

1. **From Microscope to Telescope.** Microscopes focus on the minutia, but a telescope looks at something much bigger! This week, Pastor Bruce mentioned that "microscope" view of life tends to zoom in on our own personal details and crises, but a "telescope" view sees God's larger redemptive plan. When was a time when you were stuck in a "microscope" perspective, focusing on your immediate problems? How might adopting a "telescope" perspective—considering God's broader plan—change how you view that situation? What practical steps can you take to remind yourself to look through God's telescope during challenging times?

2. **Waiting for God's Perfect Timing.** Joseph waited 13 years before his situation changed (**Genesis 41:1-13**), showing trust in God's timing. **Read Isaiah 40:30-31 and Psalm 27:13-14.** How do these passages reinforce the importance of waiting on God? Discuss how these scriptures offer encouragement or guidance for trusting God's timing in your current circumstances. What challenges do you face in waiting patiently, and how can these verses help you persevere?

Food for Thought (continued)

3. **Responding with Faith Intact.** Joseph responded to Pharaoh's request with faith, crediting God for his ability to interpret dreams (**Genesis 41:15-16**). Recall a time when an unexpected opportunity arose in your life (big or small). How did you respond, and looking back, could you have leaned more on faith in that moment? How can you cultivate a mindset like Joseph's, ready to respond with faith intact, even after hardship?
4. **Maintaining Trust in God During Success.** Joseph's rise to power (**Genesis 41:46-57**) tested his faith, yet he honored God through naming his sons with Hebrew names. **Read Proverbs 30:8-9 and Deuteronomy 8:11-18.** Compare and contrast the warnings and wisdom in these passages about trusting God during abundance or success. How do these scriptures challenge you to stay focused on God when things are going well? What are a few practical steps you can take to guard against pride or self-reliance in times of blessing?

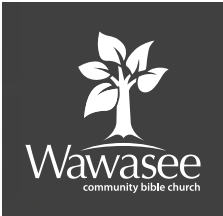
