## Food for Thought *(continued)*

**Wednesday** | <sup>8</sup> The Lord is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love. <sup>9</sup> He will not always chide, nor will he keep his anger forever. <sup>10</sup> He does not deal with us according to our sins, nor repay us according to our iniquities. <sup>11</sup> For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his steadfast love toward those who fear him; <sup>12</sup> as far as the east is from the west, so far does he remove our transgressions from us.

**Thursday** | <sup>13</sup> As a father shows compassion to his children, so the Lord shows compassion to those who fear him. <sup>14</sup> For he knows our frame; he remembers that we are dust. <sup>15</sup> As for man, his days are like grass; he flourishes like a flower of the field; <sup>16</sup> for the wind passes over it, and it is gone, and its place knows it no more. <sup>17</sup> But the steadfast love of the Lord is from everlasting to everlasting on those who fear him, and his righteousness to children's children, <sup>18</sup> to those who keep his covenant and remember to do his commandments.

**Friday** | <sup>19</sup> The Lord has established his throne in the heavens, and his kingdom rules over all. <sup>20</sup> Bless the Lord, O you his angels, you mighty ones who do his word, obeying the voice of his word! <sup>21</sup> Bless the Lord, all his hosts, his ministers, who do his will! <sup>22</sup> Bless the Lord, all his works, in all places of his dominion. Bless the Lord, O my soul!
